GENERAL REFUSE/COLLECTION REQUIREMENTS

STANDARD CART OPTION
95-Gal Trash + 65-Gal Recycle

95-Gallon Refuse Cart Option

Under the 95-gallon option, the resident will receive one 95-gallon refuse cart and will be billed the monthly rate. The resident will have the 95-gallon refuse cart collected with no need to have a refuse sticker attached. Each additional container of refuse will be required to have a prepaid refuse sticker attached in order to be collected.

65-Gallon Refuse Cart Option

Under the 65-gallon option, the resident will receive one 65-gallon refuse cart and will be billed the monthly rate. The resident will have the 65-gallon refuse cart collected with no need to have a refuse sticker attached. Each additional container of refuse will be required to have a prepaid refuse sticker attached in order to be collected.

35-Gallon Refuse Cart Option

Under the 35-gallon option, the resident will receive one 35-gallon refuse cart and will be billed the monthly rate. The resident will have the 35-gallon refuse cart collected with no need to have a refuse sticker attached. Each additional container of refuse will be required to have a prepaid refuse sticker attached in order to be collected.

Pay by the Sticker Service w/65-Gallon Recycling Toter

Under the "pay by the sticker" option, residents selecting this option will be billed the monthly rate and will be required to use a prepaid refuse sticker for each bag of refuse to be collected. Under this option the resident will receive unlimited recycling collection using the contractor supplied 65-gallon recycling cart and unlimited yard waste collection during the yard-waste season using Kraft paper bags or Bundles.

Additional Carts

Additional Refuse carts are available at a rental cost by Flood Bros, this would avoid residents being required to place each additional refuse bag with a pre-paid refuse sticker.

Additional carts are available for those residents that would be interested; a rental price would be applied.

All equipment will be owned and maintained by Flood Bros.

Any refuse that cannot fit into the Flood Bros issued cart must be placed in a bag or container not to exceed 32-gallons or 50lbs with a prepaid refuse sticker attached in order to be collected.

RECYCLING

Under ALL refuse options the resident will receive unlimited recycling collection using the Flood Bros supplied 65-gallon toter.

Additional carts are available for those residents that would be interested; a rental price would be applied.

All equipment will be owned and maintained by Flood Bros.

Flood Bros will allow recycling materials to be comingled (i.e. plastic, glass, metal and paper products mixed together). Flood Bros will provide upon request preparation requirements for households participating in the recycling program including, rinsing, removing labels, flattening, removing caps and lids.

Flood Bros Disposal Co. will collect recyclables curbside using the single stream process. There is no limit to the number of recycling bins or to the quantity of recyclables that a household may place at the curb for collection. Residents have the right to set out recycling bins which are clearly marked for recycling collection and do not exceed 35 gallons or 50lbs. Flood Bros Disposal Co. will collect from all the recycling bins that have been placed neatly at the curb for collection.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Flood Bros shall provide weekly collection of an unlimited amount of yard-waste properly placed for pick up at each collection location. All single-family customers with an active refuse account are eligible for the yard waste program. The yard waste program shall run each year for a 36-week period; starting the first Monday of April and running until the last Friday in November using Kraft paper bags, 33-gallon containers, or in bundles. Customers are also able to rent 95-gallon carts directly from Flood Bros. Yard waste consisting of bundles of brush or branches must be securely tied, using biodegradable cord, string, rope, or twine and may not exceed fifty (50) pounds in weight, two (2) feet in diameter, and four (4) feet in length. Residents that reside in a HOA development that opts out will not receive seasonal yard waste collection.

BULK ITEMS

As part of the regularly scheduled refuse collection, Flood Bros will collect one (1) Bulk Item from each collection stop as part of the weekly refuse collection at no charge. Bulk Items are to be placed by the customer at the curb. All additional items will be at the cost of one pre-paid refuse disposal sticker.

SPRING CLEAN UP

Flood Bros will provide on one (1) occasion per year and at no extra charge, curbside collection and disposal service, for the general purpose of a Spring cleanup for residences within the Village that have an active refuse account. During this Clean-up, there shall be no limit on the size or quantity of allowable materials being disposed of within the Village by its residents. Household hazardous wastes, such as gasoline, solvents, pesticides, motor oil, pool chemicals, paint thinner, will not be accepted.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

Christmas trees will be collected the first three weeks in January.

WHITE GOODS

Flood Bros Disposal Co. will also provide collection services for white good items (i.e. appliances) for a fee. Examples shall include; refrigerators, dish washers, water heaters, washers, dryers, etc. Residents will be asked to call our office 24 hours prior to collection to schedule the pickup at an additional charge.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Flood Bros would inform residents to reach out to our office when a possible hazardous waste material may need to be disposed of. We will work with the resident to find the best solution for disposal with the assistance of McHenry Recycling programs.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

Construction and remodeling debris must be contained in either cans or plastic bags not exceeding 34 gallons in size and 50 pounds in weight. Construction and remodeling debris that cannot be containerized must be securely tied and bundled. Bundles must not exceed 4 feet in length and 50 pounds in weight. Construction and remodeling debris must be from handyman type projects and may not exceed one cubic yard in quantity. Flood Bros. has rolloff dumpsters available for construction debris.

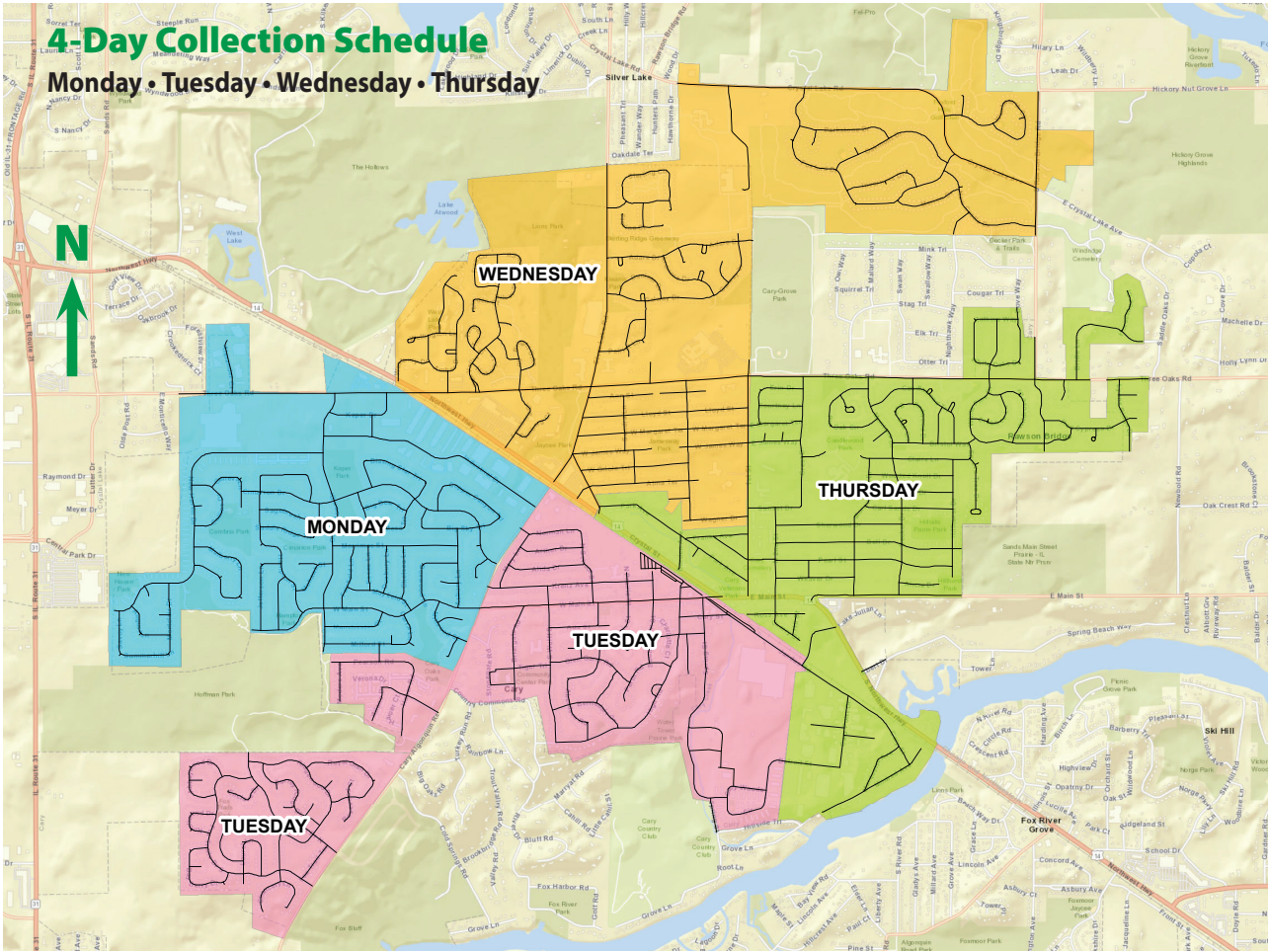
HOLIDAY SCHEDULE
